**WESLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES PARTNERS WITH SPCA AND IAMS
TO PROVIDE MEALS-ON-WHEELS TO PETS**

Wesley Community Services (WCS), a non-profit organization providing services to Greater Cincinnati seniors, has forged a ground-breaking alliance with SPCA Cincinnati and The Iams Company. This unique collaboration will enable WCS clients to receive free, premium pet nutrition for their cats and dogs. The program, entitled Pet Portions, will begin June 1st.

After participating in a trial run of Pet Portions, WCS client Camille Price said, "It's the best gift I ever got in my life! I feel rich. I'd do without food myself for my cat."

Wesley Community Services conceived the program after noticing that clients were sometimes sharing their Meals-On-Wheels food with their pets. "Many seniors' sole companion is their pet, but quite a few of our clients can't afford to buy pet food," says Stephen Smookler, WCS Executive Director. "We realized we could do a better job of keeping our seniors healthy and happy by keeping their pets healthy and happy."

Bill Reusing, WCS Director of Development, approached Andy Mahlman, Director of Operations, at SPCA Cincinnati with the idea. Mahlman liked the concept and took it to Connie McKamey, Manager-Corporate Contributions at The Iams Company. Iams agreed to provide the dog and cat food, which will be delivered to the SPCA for storage until distributed by Wesley Community Services.

Wesley Community Services, established in 1992, provides Meals-On-Wheels, medical transportation, and homemaker/housecleaning services to seniors in Greater Cincinnati. In 2005 WCS provided nearly 1,800 seniors with 189,000 meals (including physician-prescribed therapeutic meals for individuals with renal disease, severe diabetes or high blood pressure), over 20,000 medical transports to physician offices and hospitals, and 13,000 hours of homemaker/housecleaning services. In addition, WCS coordinates WesleyLinks, a collaborative effort of over 65 area churches seeking to provide information and assistance to senior congregation members in need of support to stay independent in their own homes. Wesley Community Services is a United Way Agency Partner.
