On December 13th, 2011, nineteen employees from Procter & Gamble served as volunteers at Wesley Community Services Meals-On-Wheels distribution center. Advance planning for nutritious snow meal delivery ensures our clients never go hungry,” stated Reverend Stephanie Tunison, Chief Executive Officer, Wesley Services Organization, parent organization for Wesley Community Services.
