What are “Senior Choice” Meals?

Wesley Community Services physician prescribed “Senior Choice” meals are for individuals with severe kidney disease, high blood pressure or diabetes. “Senior Choice” meals are nutritionally balanced meals prepared either pureed or mechanical soft. “Senior Choice” meals contain no added processed ingredients and are delivered weekly to your door by professional drivers.

Who is eligible?

If you answer yes to the following questions, you may qualify for home delivered “Senior Choice” meals from Wesley Community Services:

- Are you at least 50 years of age?
- Do you live in Hamilton County?
- Do you live alone and not able to prepare meals for yourself?
- Do you have a serious illness?
- Do you have kidney disease, high blood pressure, or diabetes?

What is the cost?

Wesley Community Services “Senior Choice” meals are available at no cost to you if you meet the eligibility requirements.
